President's Welcome, Kevin Page

Approval of minutes from September, 2019 (Kristy Dekat)

Treasurer's report, Stacy Sparks

Stacy Sparks presented details of the treasurer's report and reported a balance on Sept. 25, 2020 is \$24,616.82.

1st Vice-President's report, Amber Brawner
